Fourth of July

The secret to enjoying a 4th of July in the Harbor is patience and preparedness. The following are ideas to assist your 4th of July planning:

- Carpool whenever possible, parking resources will be stretched to the limit. Come early and plan to stay until after the fireworks.
- Bring supplies to your boat a week early.
- Absolutely no personal fireworks are allowed in the harbor due to the fire risk.
- Prior to the fireworks most parking lots will fill to capacity, and streets may be closed by police services. Additional parking is available at Dana Hills High School with free shuttles to the Harbor.
- Most of all please be patient, courteous, and safe during the holiday.

In conjunction with the holiday OC Parks and the City of Dana Point are planning a number of measures to help make the holiday a little easier:

- Relocating Catalina Express parking from Marina lots.
- Auxiliary parking at Dana Hills High School with shuttles to the harbor.
- In-harbor shuttle and boater cargo shuttles.
- Providing Security and Attendants to monitor parking lots.
- More information on these measures will follow.



Rule Reminders

The following rule violations have been noted recently. Be advised these rules have been in place for over 30 years and if you didn't get caught last year isn't an excuse to break them now.

- Marina Rule 11 HIGH RISK FIRE HAZARDS which are prohibited include:
 - ◊ Refueling at dockside
 - ◊ Storing flammables in your dock box
 - ◊ The use of barbeques on the dock
- Marina Rule 19 storage of anything on the docks is prohibited (inhibits emergency access). The only exception is the marina provided dock box and a set of steps (not to be used for storage).
